Warsaw's Elementary Schools Hold Their Second Cross Country Invite

Thursday, September 26, 2024, was a near perfect day for a cross country meet. With the lower temps compared to two weeks ago, PRs were commonplace in all races. The most exciting race of the evening was the 3rd/4th grade girls mile. It was won again by Jubilee Simfukwe of Jefferson in 9:39.4, nine seconds faster than two weeks ago. What made this race so exciting is that four new runners finished in the top ten compared to the previous meet (Sept. 12). It will be anybody's guess as to which team takes home the trophy in this race next Wednesday, October 2 in the City Meet. (This meet was originally scheduled for October 3). In the first invite, Jefferson and Madison had two runners each in the top ten. In the second invite, Jefferson once again took the top two spots, but Eisenhower also had two runners in the top 10, while Leesburg had three runners in the top ten compared to one at the first invite. In the boys 3rd/4th grade mile run, the top ten looked almost identical to the September 12 race. One difference was Eisenhower's Crew Wiggins took first in 6:32.7 beating last week's winner - John Warner from Leesburg - by six seconds. Once again, Eisenhower had four runners in the top ten. In the girls 5th/6th grade 1.5 mile competition, Elliott Lock from Claypool displaced Jefferson's Lucy Purdy as the first to cross the finish line. Lock finished in 10:31 - 39 seconds faster than two weeks ago! This race saw nine of the top ten from the first invite return to the top ten. Eisenhower and Leesburg both had three finishers in the top ten this week. Once again, the boys 5th/6th grade 1.5 mile was won by Eisenhower's Magnus Granger in 9:40.0. The Eisenhower boys are the clear favorites next week if they run as they have so far this season putting five finishers in the top ten in both invitationals.

Join us October 2 at 5:45pm at Warsaw High School to see who will be crowned city champions as the first elementary cross country season culminates.
